

Provision of academic support through scholarships for out of school children in Junior Secondary schools across Nigeria. THE JOURNEY SO FAR

Education

As at February 2022, SBO Foundation has successfully funded Fifty (50) female students who were on the verge of dropping out of school. These girls who are based in Gbessa, a community in Abuja Municipal Area Council (AMAC), were enrolled in SBO's 2021/2022 scholarship program. Learning materials such as notebooks, textbooks, school bags, uniforms, and all necessary study kits needed by the girls for the academic session were made available to all beneficiaries (SBO Seeds).

Social and Moral Development

At SBO Foundation, we provide counselling, advocacy and mentorship to all our seeds. Currently, the foundation has over hundred children who are taught bi-weekly on personal hygiene, female rights, manners and etiquette in addition to other social developmental skills. These are executed through our Hear to Heart Sessions, Faith School (Optional), Monthly Trainings and skill empowerment outreaches.

Welfare Outreach

SBO Foundation understands the importance of holistic care in ensuring maximum cognitive development. As such, we routinely provide amenities to our seeds to ensure their focus is maintained on academic excellence. Via our outreach programs, we provide sanitary ware, personal items, health screenings, food items, amongst other items. These are distributed during our activations, end of session events and/or monthly sessions.

My name is Sidikat Rufai I am 13 years old and a JSS 1 Student.


I want to become a nurse, so I can care for the sick and help save their lives.
